2016-17 Policies, Guidelines and Packaging Charts

Equity Grant Packaging

It is the policy of Washington State University to attempt to provide equity grant funding for:

- Financial aid applicants entering fall 2016, who have submitted a FAFSA by **February 15, 2016 and are file ready by May 16, 2016.**
- New students entering, spring 2017, who have submitted a **FAFSA or WASFA by February 15th, file ready by December 1st.** Cougar Commitment eligible students must have **applied to WSU by November 15th.** The May 15th file ready date does not apply to this group.

Check the specific item types within each formula to verify the on-time date. Students who did not meet the priority dates above are packaged on a funds available basis (this includes students attending spring semester only).

SNG & CBS Interaction Rules

Per State policy, there is 100% coordination between College Bound Scholarship & State Need Grant Awarding. Regardless of Institutional priority deadlines, CBS eligible students will be awarded for the maximum SNG award they are eligible for up to 65% MFI within available SNG resources. CBS student prioritization within SNG for maximum SNG awards will not be impacted or reduced by institutional gift equity policies or by institutional SNG-based prioritization policies, such as prioritizing by MFI level.

Self Help Requirements

WSU ensures award packages that include State Need Grant funding are subject to the program's 25% self-help rule, where 25% of the student's total cost of attendance must be covered with self-help aid, such as work-study, loans, EFC, or scholarships. SNG self-help requirements are waived for CBS eligible students. The SNG self help requirement is 12% for "at home" students with a Rm & Bd Living at Home Budget. Passport funding are considered self-help for the purposes of meeting the 25% self-help requirement within SNG.

State Aid Award Order

WSU awards state financial aid in the following order (assuming the student meets all eligibility standards for the program in question):

1. State Need Grant (SNG)
2. Passport to College
3. Other state grant funds
4. College Bound Scholarships (CBS)
5. State Work Study (SWS)

Work Study Awarding

Work Study awarding is not included in automated packaging but to be considered for possible funding eligibility, the following applies:

- Student meets the priority FAFSA filing deadline of February 15th
- Student has checked on their FAFSA they wish to be considered for Work Study funding
- Student has to have an Actual Financial Aid Award with at least \$1000 of unmet need eligibility
- Student must find an approved Work Study job.
- Student's completed WSAF is processed and they are manually awarded Work Study by the Pullman Campus Work Study Program team.

WASFA Awarding – State Need Grant & Cougar Commitment

Students who qualify for State Need Grant & Cougar Commitment Award through the WASFA process are manually awarded this funding source as these students are not FAFSA filers. SNG funding eligibility is based off WSU's packaging policy for awarding these funds (priority dates, MFI ranges and limits). These students are not eligible for funding sources awarded from the FAFSA.

Perkins & Nursing Loan Checklist Assignments

When assigning the Perkins and Nursing Loan checklist click on the "Variable Data" button. Not only do you need to add the aid year for these checklist items they also identify the student's career and item type of the loan. Subsidized & Unsubsidized Direct Loan must be awarded first for Perkins Recipients. Perkins Loan will not increase after initial awarding in automated mass packaging.
